New Antibiotic Guidelines

The American Heart Association recently released new guidelines for heart patients' use of antibiotics prior to dental treatment. The guidelines are based on a growing body of scientific evidence that shows the risks of taking preventative antibiotics outweigh the benefits for most patients. Far fewer patients now need antibiotics prior to dental treatment. Staff members will try to advise patients if their status changes.

Introducing CEREC CAD/CAM Dentistry

We are pleased to offer our patients Cerec restorations—precisely designed, color-matched and highly durable ceramic restorations! Cerec restorations, which include onlays, inlays and crowns for posterior teeth are completed right in our office in a single visit.

After anesthetic is administered, the tooth is prepared in much the same way as before. Cerec then uses a digital 3D camera

to create a computer image of the prepared tooth. This digital image replaces the physical impression previously required—patients no longer have to wait while a tray of impression goop hardens in the mouth! While the patient relaxes, the restoration is designed on our computer screen, then sent to our in-house lab to be milled. About 15 minutes later, the new restoration is

ready to be fitted, polished and bonded for performance. That's right, no second appointment! The tooth is restored back to its natural form, function and beauty in one sitting. The doctors are currently restoring posterior teeth with this methodology, but plan to include anterior teeth within a year.
